The ACPO orphanage and Transit Center feeds around 110 orphans and staff per day. With the photos I want to give you a glimpse of the children and staff as they live day-by-day in the large orphan's community. I am thankful to be able to report that even though they were cooped up for months within the orphan compound, not being allowed to go to school or to the village, none of the children or staff have suffered from COVID 19.



Jose, ACPO accountant says: "May the Lord bless all of you who help us to be able to continue to feed the children. The orphans are on their way to school. On behalf of them I say a big thank you to Harvest Community Church and Fairhaven Church Vacation Bible School fundraisers for helping ACPO buy uniforms, school bags, shoes and writing materials so that the orphans could go to school.

The Dream Bigger Vision is continuing now in Mhandarume, Zimbabwe. A vision of expanding and blessing this nation was birthed this last year. The building of a Worship and Training Center is almost finished! As the local people were seeing what was being built, they came-and were employed to carry water for the cement, then declared "we want to attend also!"

The churches have begun using the storage building for meetings in late November. The well is soon to come, and then the roof, doors and windows on the assembly building.

In the words of Pastor Rego "The churches in Zimbabwe will unite and grow as they have a common place to meet." We are seeing this word come to pass as the Spirit of God moves in Zimbabwe amongst the Mountain of Praise Churches.

Please be praying for the finishing of this mighty move as the gospel goes out to those in this area.



Much work went into transferring over 1000 boxes of scripture booklets! It was a challenge to transfer from shipping truck into MOP container located within the security wall. MOP Truck had to hall (couple trips) from shipping truck outside the gate and bring into compound before booklets could be transferred to MOP container.
